OFFENSE: Homicide
SUBJECT: James C. Snow
VICTIM: William Little

REQUEST:

At the request of Detective Charles Crowe, the subject listed above was examined by the polygraph detection of deception technique at the Springfield Forensic Science Laboratory in Springfield, Illinois, on September 1, 1994. The polygraph examination was administered to investigate whether or not the subject listed above was involved in the shooting death of William Little.

RESULTS:

There were no emotional responses indicative of deception in this subject's polygraph records on the following questions:

"On March 31, 1994, did you rob the Clark station at Empire and Linden in Bloomington?"

Answer: No

"Did you shoot William Little?"

Answer: No

"Did you conspire with anyone to rob the Clark station?"

Answer: No

It is the opinion of the examiner, based on the polygraph records, that this subject was truthful to the above questions.
